Pool Management on the navigation pane contains three sections:

- Waiting List
- Urgent TWL Recipients
- Transplanted Recipients



INTRODUCTION TO POOL MANAGEMENT

Pool management can be used to view groups of patients. The groups include:

- Waiting Lists current list of recipients enrolled for an organ transplant. This includes all pathways Transplant Waiting List (TWL- Deceased donor), Living Directed Donor (LDD) and Kidney Paired Donor (KPD) program.
- Urgent patients
- Transplanted patients

1. WAITING LIST

The waiting list allows users to view lists of all recipients and donors enrolled in an Organ program or Transplant pathway. When an organ program is selected, all recipients who are enrolled in that organ program are displayed on the screen. For the TWL pathway a row is shaded green when the recipient is active and ready. For the LDD and KPD pathways a row is shaded green when the recipient and donor are active and ready.

- Status Active
- Optionally filter by **SAG Readiness Expiry** to review patients with SAG expiring within set timeframes (e.g. Within 10 days, Between 11 and 20 days, or Expired). SAG expiry is calculated from the date of the sample of the most recent Single Antigen result.

- Optionally filter further by Transplant Hospital or Clinical Hospital
